Teaching today – attractive scholarships and incentives are available

Providing good training to great people creates a quality teaching workforce for Victorian government schools. Teaching today offers career advancement, management and leadership opportunities.

To encourage the right people to qualify and teach in Victorian government schools a range of scholarship and incentive programs have been created.

Maths and Science Scholarships offer grants of up to \$9,000 to attract science or mathematics graduates to teaching. Recipients will complete a graduate entry teaching course and be encouraged to teach in Victorian government schools.

Student Teacher Practicum Scheme provides a \$900 living away from home allowance when placed at a rural school or \$300 travel allowance when travelling more than 50 kilometres each way to a placement school in a rural or metropolitan growth area.

Career Change Program enables professionals to become trainee teachers in hard-to-staff government schools. Financial support and paid study leave is on offer as well as offers of ongoing employment.

Teaching Scholarships Scheme allows recent graduates or final year teaching students to apply for a teaching scholarship of up to \$9,000 and an offer of ongoing employment in a Victorian government school.

Graduate Recruitment Program provides those who graduated less than four years ago with an opportunity to apply for specially designated graduate vacancies in Victorian government schools.

Recruitment Online helps teachers identify teaching jobs and allows them to upload their resume to the website and apply for any job. This includes information on scholarship or graduate vacancies online. Principals can search the website for potential applicants to fill vacancies.
