Students had been on an excursion to the Police Academy. The excursion was discussed and students were asked to write a recount of their trip or about the police in their birth country. The task was not scaffolded. The text is a first draft.

**The text shows that the student:**

writes using repetitive structures e.g. In Burma

has control over known structures

does not use paragraphs to organise his writing

uses mostly standard word order

writes using various tenses, not always correctly

uses limited conjunctions

attempts to express some complex ideas

uses punctuation inconsistently

uses a limited number of adjectives
