



## Progress Pass

### Description:

A Progress Pass is a small pass or ticket that students to gain at the end of a lesson that allows them to quickly reflect on what they have achieved and where they need assistance. It helps them to record and track their own progress through a learning task or activity.

### How could I use it?

- ★ For reflection during an assignment, unit or topic.
- ★ As a process to refocus a student.
- ★ As a quick and simple tool for student self-assessment.

### Why should I use it?

- ★ It is a structured process that promotes higher order thinking to reflect on what has been achieved during a lesson and where future efforts and support should be focussed in the next lesson.

### When should I use it? ★ At the end of a lesson.

## How do I use it?

★ A number of passes can be made for students to complete in the last few minutes of a lesson.

★ The Progress Pass can be used for any research task or assignment that is currently being undertaken by a class. They can be generic or quite specific.

The following are examples of Progress Passes:
