Delegates will then be invited to present 'their' country's position on education.

Teams will be allocated a country and a Delegate Pack will be provided to assist preparation.

This activity has been funded by the Australian Government as part of the Values Education Professional Learning Package. The program will develop resource links with initiatives such as Multicultural Education, Civics & Citizenship Education, Global Education and Human Rights Education.
